### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

# 32x Quaternary Concentrate

A blend of cationic detergents to clean and deodorize surfaces not damaged by water.

Uses:

Clean and deodorize synthetic turf fields.

Clean and deodorize cement slabs after sewer backup.

Concentrated. Do not use straight.

Dilute 1 part product with 32 parts water

This equates to 4 oz /gal or 1 oz per quart or 32 mL per liter One quart makes 8 gallons of ready-to-use solution.

One gallon makes 32 gallons of ready-to-use solution.

Apply with pump-up sprayer, trigger sprayer, automatic floor scrubber or similar. Useful for automatic floor scubbers on cement or unfinished (un-waxed) tile.

For best results, keep surfaces wet for 10 minutes.

For toilet bowls use straight: 2 oz (60mL) in bowl of clean water. Scrub.

Let stand 10 minutes then flush.

NOTE: Toxic to fish. Keep away from natural waterways.
