Stop use and ask a doctor if

   pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days
   fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- if ringing in the ears or loss of hearing occurs
   redness or swelling is present in the painful area
   any new symptoms appear

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use aspirin at 20 weeks or later in pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in he unborn child or complications during delivery.
