DO NOT USE:

- If the solution changes color or gets cloudy
- With contact lenses
- If any open wounds exist in or near the eye or an object is embedded

WHEN USING THIS PRODUCT:

- Remove contact lenses before using
- Do not re-use once opened

STOP USE AND ASK A DOCTOR IF:

- You experience eye irritation, pain, or continued redness

Directions:

Tamper evident packaging, do not use if seal around the top is opened, broken or missing. Do not use past the expiration date.

Adults and children over 6:	Open top, flush affected area as needed, controlling rate of flow by pressure on the bottle. Do not touch tip of bottle to any surface.
Children under 6:	Consult a doctor or pharmacist
