## **Usage information:**

- 1. Dispense or mix according to dilution chart.
- 2. Apply solution to surface to be cleaned.
- 3. Allow Power Clean time to penetrate and disperse the soils.
- 4. Agitation with a brush or scrubbing pad may speed up the cleaning action.
- 5. Once soils are loosened, simply wipe away with a cloth or towel.
