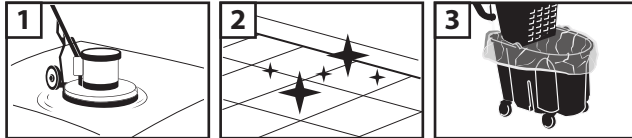

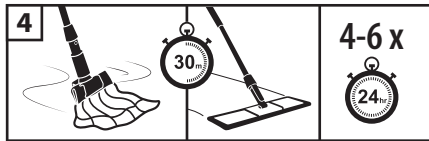
Directions



1 Strip floors with Coastwide 82 / 83 or top scrub with Coastwide 64.

2 Ensure floor is clean and dry before application.

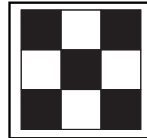
3 Line mop bucket with trash bag to avoid contamination.



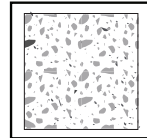
4 With clean Rayon mop / microfiber flat mop apply 4–6 coats over 24 hours (30 minutes between coats). Only use in a well-ventilated area.

Maintenance Procedures:
Frequently dust mop, clean daily with Coastwide 64 or 50, buff/burnish as needed.

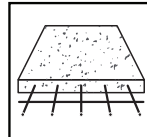

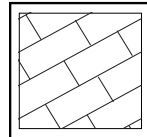
